PROJECT SUMMARY

What was Summer Staycation?

The Doncaster Summer Staycation was a Doncaster Council project which saw local organisations deliver FREE activities and sessions, both virtually and face-to-face, for children during the summer holidays.

The project saw Active Fusion deliver summer camps, which were spread across seven different locations in Doncaster, throughout the summer holidays.

Our Summer Sports Camps, which saw 446 children attend, included a variety of sports and physical activity sessions for children to take part in throughout the week.

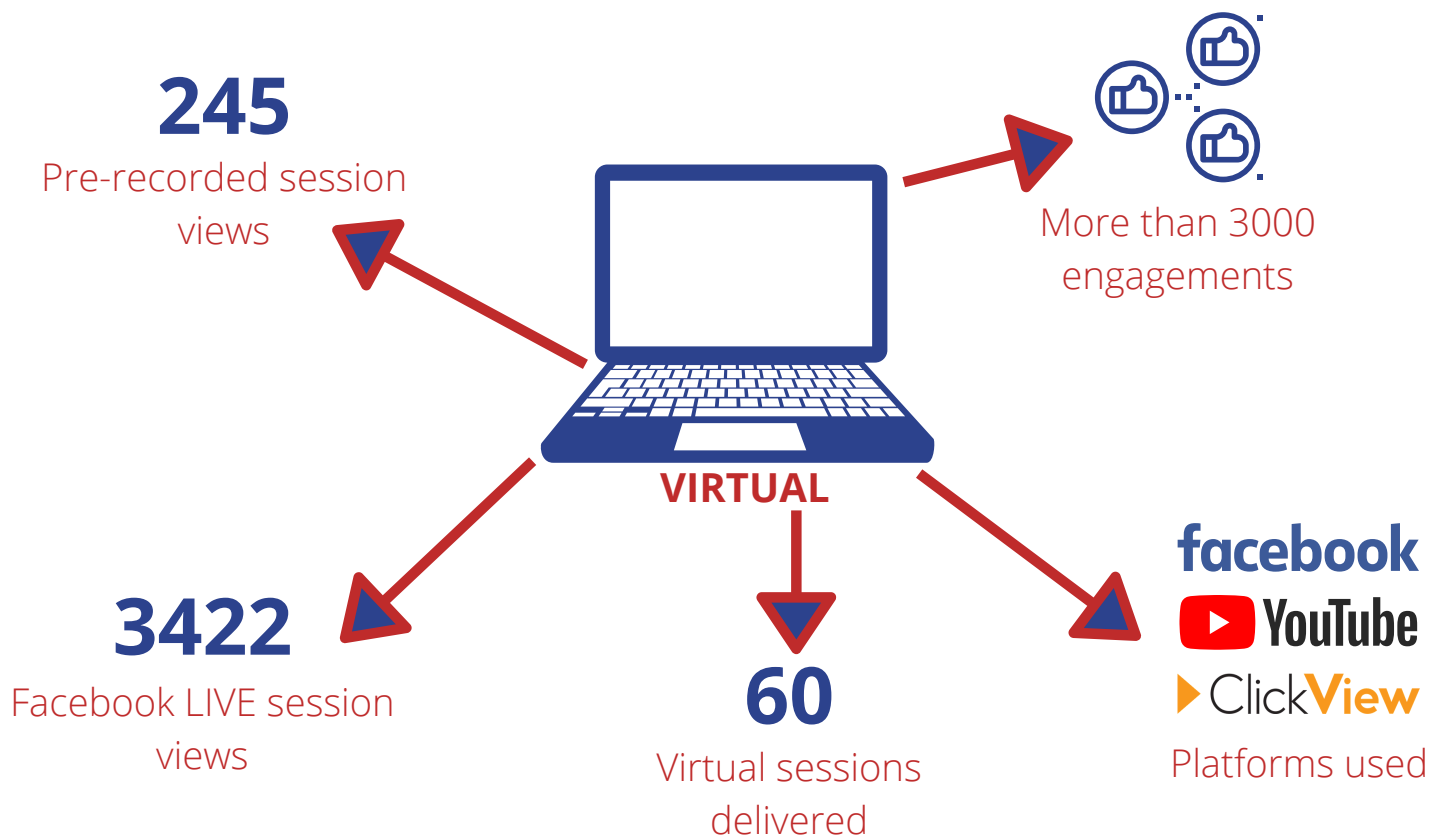
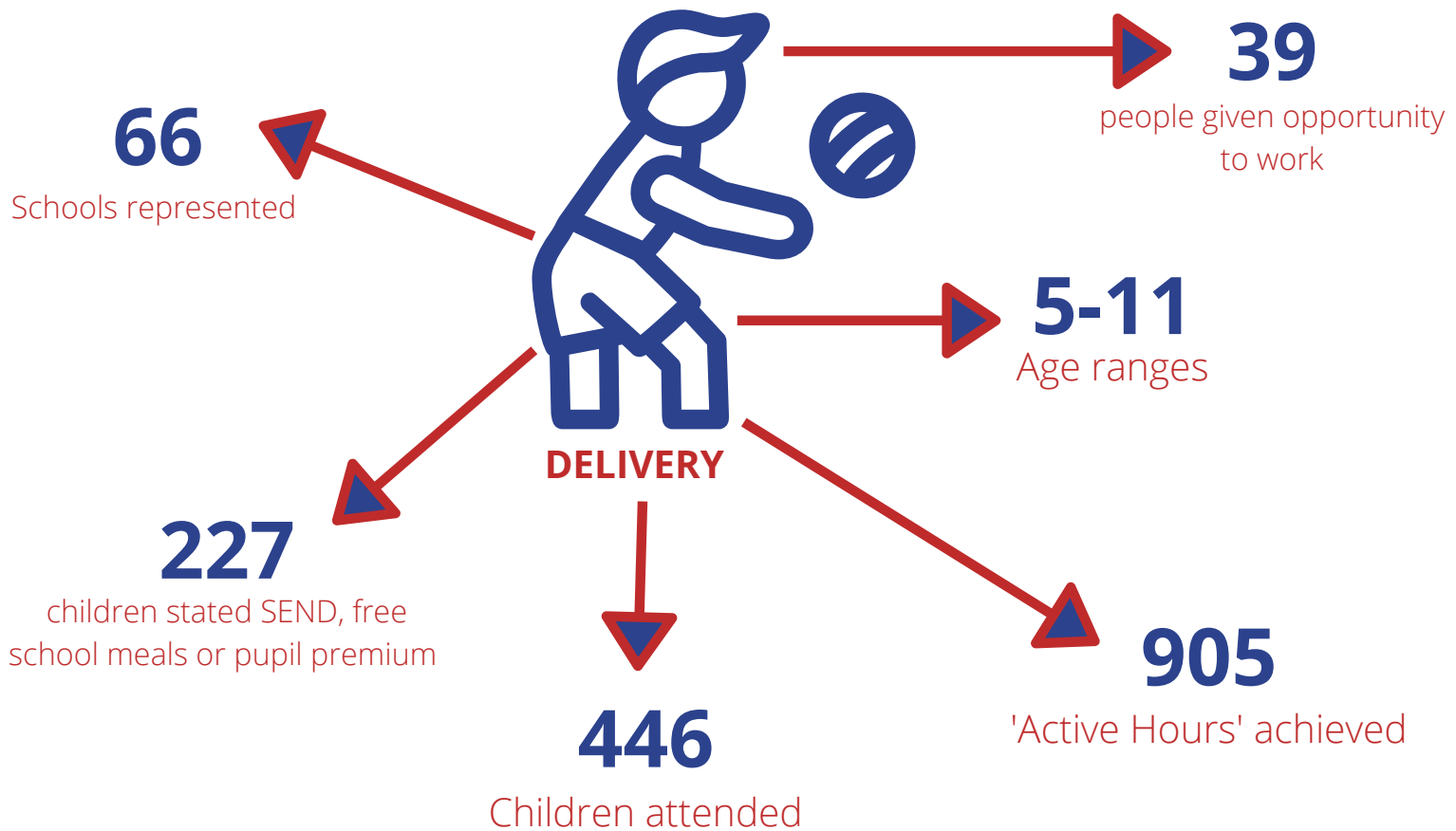
Children were also able to access learning resources and ideas for keeping active at home such as our PE Parent pack.

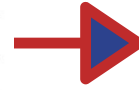
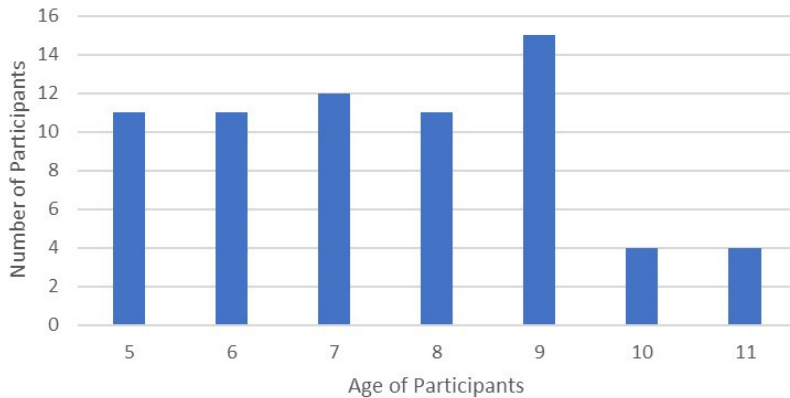

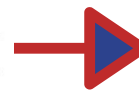
FIGURES FROM IVANHOE CAMP

female



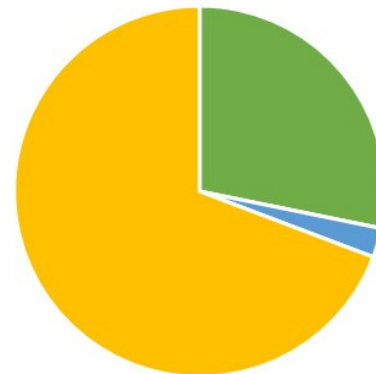

Sometimes children just need to be children. They needed something positive to happen – and we are glad 446 children from across Doncaster were able to experience the enjoyment and happiness on camp.

Jess, Maddox and Harry all attended the Ivanhoe camp, and were so happy to have spent their summer socialising with friends, making new friends and trying different things.



Jessica said: "I've really enjoyed camp. It has made me feel really happy being here with my friends. I've really enjoyed the gymnastics and found camp to be really exciting. I haven't been to school in such a long time, I think a lot of things have changed, so I was pretty nervous and didn't want to go. As I got to camp, I was really excited and the coaches really helped me settle in and I have had loads of fun."

Maddox added: "I really liked camp. It made me happy and I got to exercise which I really enjoy. It has been great!"

Harry said: "I liked coming to camp because I could see all my friends, do exercise and play new games I didn't know about before. I didn't get to see my friends much during lockdown so it was nice to play with my friends on camp."
