

Area of English: Writing

Skill: Begins to break the flow of speech into words

YOU WILL NEED...

Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

Equipment:

A4 paper divided into three sections and pencils.



Instructions:

1. Tell children they are going to make a new animal.
2. They can decide what it is going to look like.
3. Give the children the piece of A4 paper. Ask them to draw the head of an animal in the top section. This could be a bird, monkey or whatever they want it to be.
4. They then fold the top section over, so the head is no longer visible.
5. Ask the children to walk around the room with their animals.
6. When the teacher says swap, they should swap their paper with the child nearest to them.
7. On the new piece of paper, ask them to draw the body of the animal.
8. Repeat steps 4, 5 and 6. This time though, after the children have swapped papers, get the children to draw the legs of the animal.
9. Once all sections have been completed ask the children to open out the paper and look at their animal.
10. Then, children will need write some words to describe their animal e.g big head.
