

**Area of English:** Writing

**Skill:** Capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences

## YOU WILL NEED...

**Resources:**

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

**Equipment:**

Story pictures.



**Instructions:**

1. Print off the pictures prior to the lesson.
2. Children work in groups of 5/6. Each group has one text (story) with each member having a picture from that story.
3. Children then verbally explain the events in the picture and write a caption underneath it to explain what is happening using capital letters and full stops.
4. The group to check each caption and edit if necessary.
5. Order the images to tell the story.
6. Children act out their story using actions and their captions.

**Teacher Tip:**

The story can be linked to your literacy text or topic to develop understanding of key sections to the story.

Groups can be made bigger to add more sections to the story.

Images can be used afterwards for a story board.

Adding an action for capital letters and full stops can be useful to remember those key skills during the writing stage.
