

Area of English: Writing

Skill: Present perfect form of verbs

YOU WILL NEED...

Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

Equipment:

Resource Cards.



Instructions:

1. Split the children into 2 groups. One group will have a character name and the other will have a card with clues about the character on it.
2. Ask the children to move around the space to music. When it stops, they need to find a partner (if someone has a name card, they need to find someone with a clue card).
3. The child with the name card can ask their partner 3 questions to find out who they are.
4. They need to decide if they think they are a match or not.
5. The music and game then continues with children trying to find their match.

Teacher Tip:

The characters could be changed to fit a particular text or topic. Children could even be challenged to write their own clues for a new set of characters.

You may want to spend some time with the children generating questions they could ask their partner to support this activity. The simplest thing is to ask for 3 things they have done that day.

Children could try and make the game harder by the answers they choose to give from their card.
