Area of English: Writing

Skill: Noun phrases expanded by the addition of modifying adjectives, nouns and preposition phrases

YOU WILL NEED...

Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

Equipment:

Hoops, picture cards x 2, sentence prompt card, whiteboards and pens.



Instructions:

- 1. Split the children into teams. Alternatively, they could work by themselves.
- 2. Put the picture cards in a hoop at one end of the hall/playground opposite each team.
- 3. When the teacher says go, the first child runs to the hoop to collect a monster picture and brings it back to their base.
- 4. The team then collectively (or the pupil independently) create a sentence about the picture using an expanded noun phrase with a modifying adjective, noun and verb.
 - E.g. The gigantic blue monster with six eyes played the drums.
- 5. When they have completed the sentence, the pupil or next member of the team runs to collect a picture and brings it back to create another sentence.
- 6. All team members must collect a card to complete the relay. For single players, you can decide how many monsters are to be collected and written about.
- 7. The winning team is the team who completes all the sentences correctly.

Teacher Tip:



To make this game more challenging, you could ask the teams to add a prepositional phrase to their sentences to add when/where details e.g. in the afternoon, on the palace steps.
